#### **Protect Yourself from Fraud**

The best way to protect yourself from fraud is to safe guard your financial information. Regularly reviewing your transactions will allow you to catch discrepancies early before fraudsters can make multiple transactions.

Make sure to never share your credit or debit card information via phone without initiating the transaction. If a call seems legitimate, ask their name, hang up, and research the businesses' official number and call them there to verify any issues. Never take someone's word that they work for a certain business or agency, especially if they have never called you before.

When able, pay inside at the register versus using free standing payment machines, such as at the pump or parking garage. If using an ATM, find one located indoors or within clear view of an attendant.
